I. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order by Mr. Schoech at 9:18 AM.

II. Approval of March Minutes

A motion was made by Dr. Mansfield to approve minutes, Dr. Long seconded. Motion carried.

III. OITS Security Course

Ms. Donnelly reminded the advisory committee they will need to complete the OITS security training by the end of year. Each committee member must complete the training modules, or they will not have access to committee information. Ms. Donnelly told the committee she would send out an email with a link to the training.

IV. Staff Updates

a) SAMHSA Grant

Ms. Donnelly presented to the committee the most recent information on the four current grants funding K-TRACS and how long each grant will last. The OD2A grant from the CDC ends August 31, 2023. K-TRACS has two grants from the BJA one

ending September 30, 2022, the second ending September 30, 2023. The newest grant is from SAMHSA with KDADS and is for 5 years ending September 30, 2026.

b) Provider Authorization

Ms. Donaldson updated the committee on provider authorization. She explained how prior authorization implementation worked and that it had been delayed by one month, but as of October 5, 2021, it was active.

c) Prescriber Reports

Ms. Donaldson explained to the committee that K-TRACS would be switching the delivery method for the PERx report. The prescribers would no longer be receiving their PERx via email but would need to log in to the K-TRACS portal for the report. Dr. Davison responded that education was needed for the prescribers so they will use the reports, and there needed to be a dual delivery (both email and portal) for the first few quarters until providers got accustomed to the change.

d) Education

Ms. Donaldson updated the committee on the development of self-paced, online education modules that will be designed to meet the Kansas Board of Healing Arts continuing education requirements for education in the area of prescription drug monitoring programs, acute and chronic pain management, and opioid prescribing.

V. Case Review-Closed Session

Dr. Long made a motion to go into closed session until 10:50 AM, Mr. Coble seconded. Motion carried.

The committee reconvened to regular session at 10:50 AM.

- Case 21-010 Dr. Long made a motion to send a letter to all prescribers listed, except the orthopedist, and a pointed letter to the APRN encouraging the provider to enroll and use K-TRACS. Dr. Mansfield seconded; motion carried.
- Case 21-011 Dr. Mansfield made a motion to notify the prescribers regarding K-TRACS enrollment and use. Dr. Long seconded; motion carried.
- Case 21-012 No action.

VI. Staff Presentation

a) Academic Detailing

Dr. Rice presented on how academic detailing was progressing. She said it is peer to peer pharmacy outreach, with five interactions with the pharmacist ranging from 15 to 30 minutes at a time. Dr. Rice noted that she has had a couple of individuals reach out to her and schedule academic detailing. Mr. Schoech commented that he would like to have it presented at a Kansas Pharmacist Association meeting for credit and may get better participation at small group settings. Ms. Donnelly asked for the committee's feedback on the academic detailing curriculum.

b) Data Validation
